

## PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY!

- Please note that ALL projects will be kept for fair entry and will be released after the fair.\*
- Participant must have filled out a 2023 4-H Enrollment Form by <u>April 28, 2023</u> to register for summer classes on May 9. Any
  enrollment forms received after that date will be noted and cannot register for summer projects until May 16th.
- School club participants MUST fill out a 2023 4-H Enrollment form to participate in Summer Project Classes.
- Absolutely NO registrations will be taken before 10:00 am on May 9th.
- Call 859-586-6101 or go online to <u>boone.ca.uky.edu</u> to register. <u>Online registration is strongly encouraged. Please check your username and password <u>PRIOR</u> to May to be sure you are able to log in. If you have misplaced or forgotten your login information, go to <u>boone.ca.uky.edu</u> to reset your information. DO NOT create a new log in on your own. This will not work as 4-H'ers have a unique log in created with their membership. If you still need help, call the Extension office at 859-586-6101.
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- Do not select **Project Days** that will repeat a class from another **Project Day**.
- Participants will remain at the Extension Office the entire day for **Project Days** (9 am-3 pm—unless otherwise noted).
- Participants should bring a packed lunch to eat during **Project Days only, unless otherwise noted**. You may also bring a mid-morning snack if you think you will need one.
- Participants <u>MUST</u> call to cancel if they are unable to attend any class for which they are registered. You may be dropped from future classes if you miss too many classes without cancellation.
- Participant needs to be on time for morning class. If late, the participant may not be permitted to complete the activity already in progress, but they will be expected to stay with the class to continue with the remainder of the **Project Day**.
- Materials are provided unless otherwise listed, and are purchased based on registration. We do not keep extra materials on hand, so DO NOT SHOW UP FOR CLASSES FOR WHICH YOU ARE NOT REGISTERED.
- Participants on waitlists will be notified if an opening occurs for a particular **Class** or **Project Day**. Do not come to the office hoping to make it into a class. The next person on a waitlist is the one entitled to be in the class.

Acrylic Painting	We will create art using Acrylic paints.	Skill Level-Easy.

Butterfly House	There are many insects that are environmentally positive. Give them a home by making your own Mason Bee House.	
Candle Making	Learning how to make different types of candles.	We will be working with hot wax & hot plates.
Collages	We're going to make a texture collage & a color collage. Let's get creative!	
Container Garden A	Create multiple container gardens & learn how to maintain them.	Fairy Garden Hanging Basket Herb Garden
