2023 enrollment expired on August 31, 2023. To be an active member, continue to receive monthly newsletters, and participate in 4-H events, summer projects, and the Boone County Fair as a 4-H member, you <u>MUST</u> re-enroll by completing the 2024 enrollment form to re-activate your membership.

Note: If you filled out a form in July, you will need to fill out a <u>2024</u> form. If you do not re-enroll for 2024 by <u>October 3, 2023</u>, you will <u>STOP</u> receiving your monthly newsletters.


ALL ROUNDERS HORSE CLUB


4-H SEW UNIQUE DESIGN CLUB














4-H LIVESTOCK CLUB

It is once again time to start the 4-H livestock club educational hours. Six hours of livestock education, taught by certified livestock leaders, is required to participate in the market and breeding divisions for county, district, and state competition.


Each participant in the market animal project must have six educational hours before the validation for

each species. This includes beef, dairy, sheep, goat, hog, rabbit, chicken and duck. The participants in the breeding animal and country ham projects must receive six educational hours before June 1, 2023. Also, the participant and his/her parent must attend the mandatory livestock meeting in January 2023. Please plan to attend meetings early in the year. Make-up time will not be given. All livestock club meetings will be held

the Extension Office unless otherwise noted.
