Approved Volunteer Locations

Revised: January 2022

For Northern Kentucky Master Gardener internships, 40 hours of volunteer service are required to complete the program.

- A <u>minimum</u> of 20 of the 40 hours <u>must</u> be from Category I: Cooperative Extension Volunteer Sites.
- 20 of the 40 hours may be done in Category 2: Approved Kentucky Volunteer Opportunities.
- Up to 5 hours of volunteerism may be done in Category 3: Out of state volunteer sites.
- Volunteers who would like to create a volunteer site should contact the Boone, Kenton or Campbell County CES offices.

For Master Gardeners doing recertification, <u>20 hours of volunteer service is required to</u> <u>maintain standing. 15 volunteer hours can be completed in any category and 5 volunteer</u> <u>hours must be completed in Category 1.</u>To remain a certified participant, you must have 10 hours of continuing education classes related to horticulture.

NO HOURS WILL BE APPROVED FOR TRANSPORTING OTHER VOLUNTEERS OR YOUR-SELF FROM MASTER GARDENER VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES.

Creating Volunteer Opportunities:

Master Gardeners may create new volunteer sites around the local community, by submitting a project proposal form. The following is a list of volunteer site criteria. Volunteer sites must fit in all categories to be approved by the program committee.

Volunteer projects must:

- Be for a non-profit organization or community horticulture service project.
- Have an educational component.
- Portray the Northern Kentucky Master Gardener Program in a positive way.
- Bring recognition to the Northern Kentucky Master Gardener Program.
- Be safe for all participants.
