Six hours of livestock education, taught by certified livestock leaders, are required to participate in the market and breeding divisions for the county, district, and state competitions. Each participant in the market animal project must have six educational hours before the validation for each species. This includes beef, dairy, sheep, goat, hog, rabbit, chicken, and duck. The participants in the breeding animal and country ham projects must receive six educational hours before June 1, 2023. Also, the participant and his/her parent must attend the mandatory livestock meeting in January 2023. Please plan to attend meetings early in the year. Make-up time will not be given. All livestock club meetings will be held at the Extension Office unless otherwise noted.

4-H COUNTRY HAM PROJECT FOR 2023

Plans are underway to start the 4-H country Ham project 2023. A contract must be signed and submitted to the Extension Office by the deadline sometime in early December. There is also a small fee attached to this project. For 2022 the fee was \$60. The curing process takes place in January, typically on Martin Luther King holiday when the school is off and runs through the Kentucky State Fair in August. All activities and supplies are provided by the Extension Office. The participant will salt cure two green hams in January and write and give a 3-5 minute speech on an assigned topic pertaining to country hams. This project will involve approximately 6 meetings. If the participant does not complete the project, the two country hams are forfeited and returned to UK. The two competitions are the county fair and state fair. We expect the contracts to be out in mid-November.
