R. C. DURR FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

Once again, the R. C. Durr Foundation will be offering 4-H Scholarships via their online platform which can be reached by going to the Application page at www.DurrFoundation.com and hitting the Apply button at the bottom of the page. Applicants must use the code **2023** or they will enter our regular request system and be very confused!

This year's deadline to apply is Friday, March 17, 2023.

The list of schools has been expanded, going from just UK to also include Northern Kentucky University, Morehead State University, Thomas More University, Eastern Kentucky University, Western Kentucky University, Gateway Community and Technical College, Maysville Technical and Community College, and Jefferson Community and Technical College.

Additionally, each scholarship is now \$3,000 per year with the scholarship automatically renewing for the student's sophomore year if the student maintains a 2.0 grade point average which would increase the total scholarship value to \$6,000.

Five scholarships will now be offered per year.

Six hours of livestock education, taught by certified livestock leaders, are required to participate in the market and breeding divisions for the county, district, and state competitions. Each participant in the market animal project must have six educational hours before the validation for each species. This includes beef, dairy, sheep, goat, hog, rabbit, chicken, and duck. The participants in the breeding animal and country ham projects must receive six educational hours before June 1, 2023. Also, the participant and his/her parent must attend the mandatory livestock meeting in January 2023. Please plan to attend meetings early in the year. Make-up time will not be given. All livestock club meetings will be held at the Extension Office unless otherwise noted.
