Six hours of livestock education, taught by certified livestock leaders, are required to participate in the market and breeding divisions for the county, district, and state competitions. Each participant in the market animal project must have six educational hours before the validation for each species. This includes beef, dairy, sheep, goat, hog, rabbit, chicken, and duck. The participants in the breeding animal and country ham projects must receive six educational hours before June 1, 2023. Also, the participant and his/her parent must attend the mandatory livestock meeting in January 2023. Please plan to attend meetings early in the year. Make-up time will not be given. All livestock club meetings will be held at the Extension Office


