What is a Cryptogram?

A Cryptogram is a coded message where each letter is replaced by a symbol. A symbol key shows you what symbol is used in place of each letter. Ranch and Chicken Wrap

Servings: 1

Serving Size: 1 wrap

Ingredients:

- 3 ounces canned or packaged chicken, drained
- 1 tablespoon light ranch dressing
- 1 tortilla
- 1/2 cup fresh spinach or lettuce
- · 2 tablespoons shredded cheese

Directions:

- 1. Stir dressing into chicken.
- 2. Place chicken mixture down in center of tortilla.
- 3. Top with cheese and spinach.
- 4. Fold the wrap around the filling and enjoy.
