

Slow Cooker Chicken Santa Fe Soup

Servings: 8 Serving Size: 2 cups





Ingredients:

- · 4 thawed boneless, skinless chicken breasts
- 1 (7 ounce) can chopped green chilies
- 1 (8 ounce) bag frozen corn
- 1 (28 ounce) can diced tomatoes, no salt added
- 1 (15 ounce) can black beans
- 1 (14 ounce) can or box vegetable broth, no salt added
- 1 (32 ounce) box low-sodium chicken broth
- 3 tablespoons low sodium chili seasoning mix

Directions:

- 1. Place all ingredients in slow cooker and simmer on low 6-8 hours or 3-4 hours on high.
- 2. Remove cooked chicken and shred with two forks.
- 3. Return chicken to soup and it is ready-to-serve.

Tips

- Eat about 5 cups of red, orange and dark-green vegetables each week. Tomatoes, carrots, sweet
 potatoes, broccoli and leafy dark green vegetables, such as kale and spinach, are good choices.
- · Vegetable broth can be replaced with chicken broth.
