Please note that all pages of the form must be completed or it will be returned to you. Each child must have their own enrollment form.

2022 enrollment expired on August 31, 2022. To be an active member, continue to receive monthly newsletters, and participate in 4-H events, summer projects, and the Boone County Fair as a 4-H member, you **MUST** re-enroll by completing the 2023 enrollment form to re-activate your membership.

Note: If you filled out a form in July or August, you will need to fill out a 2023 form. If you do not re-enroll for 2023 by October 3, 2022, you will STOP receiving your monthly newsletters.






