Heads up!

From July 17th through August 24th Earth will be passing the Perseid meteor shower. Look to the skies on the night of August 12th into the early hours of the 13th for the best viewing time.

- 1. Find a location away from light pollution (turn off any lights you can)
- 2. Let your eyes adjust to the dark.
- 3. Keep looking! Meteors travel at 37 miles per second! Each is visible for only a second or two.

KID APPROVED RECIPE



Easy Granola Bars

Ingredients:

- 2 cups quick oats
- 1 cup peanut butter
- 2 tablespoons sliced almonds
- 1/4 cup honey
- 1/4 cup raisins or dried cranberries (optional)

Directions:

- 1. Mix together ingredients in a medium-sized bowl.
- 2. Line a 9×9 square pan or 7×11 rectangular pan with parchment paper and press the granola into the pan until evenly distributed.
- 3. Place pan in freezer for one hour until granola is firm. Cut into 14 bars.
